

Safety Guidelines for Students of Jalal-Abad International University

Ensuring the safety and wellbeing of every student is one of our university's highest priorities. This comprehensive guide outlines essential safety protocols that every student must follow whilst on campus, in academic buildings, dormitories, and the "Shifa" clinic. Understanding and adhering to these guidelines will help create a secure learning environment for our entire community.



General Safety Requirements



Follow Regulations

Adhere to internal regulations and safety instructions during all lectures, laboratory classes, practical sessions, and simulation training activities.



Report Hazards

Immediately report any dangerous situation to your instructor, campus administration, or security personnel without delay.



Equipment Safety

Never use damaged equipment, faulty sockets, or malfunctioning electrical devices. Report issues straight away.

Cleanliness Standards

Maintain cleanliness and order in all classrooms, common areas, and dormitories. A tidy environment contributes to overall safety and prevents accidents.

Emergency Preparedness

Review the evacuation plans posted throughout buildings and familiarise yourself with the locations of all emergency exits on your regular routes.

Fire Safety

Essential Knowledge and Procedures

Fire safety is paramount in protecting lives and property. Every student must be familiar with fire prevention measures and emergency response procedures.

Know Your Equipment

Identify the locations of fire extinguishers, fire alarm pull stations, fire hoses, and emergency exits in every building you frequent.

Maintain Clear Routes

Keep all evacuation routes, corridors, and stairways completely unobstructed at all times. Never store items in these critical pathways.

Prevent Fire Hazards

Avoid using open flames, candles, or incense. Do not overload electrical sockets or use multiple high-power devices simultaneously.

In Case of Smoke or Fire

1. Immediately call **101** (Fire Department) or **112** (Unified Emergency Number)
2. Notify campus security and administration personnel
3. Leave the building calmly and orderly, following the designated evacuation plan

Electrical Safety



Critical Electrical Safety Protocols

Electrical hazards pose serious risks, including electric shock, burns, and fire. Following proper electrical safety procedures is essential for preventing accidents and injuries.

Use Only Functioning Appliances

Operate only electrical appliances that are in proper working condition. Check cords, plugs, and devices for any signs of damage, fraying, or exposed wires before use.

Keep Hands Dry

Never touch electrical wires, switches, plugs, or equipment with wet hands or whilst standing in water. Always ensure your hands are completely dry.

Report Malfunctions Immediately

Report any electrical malfunction, sparking, burning smell, or unusual behaviour to the responsible maintenance staff or administration without delay.

Safety in Laboratories and Simulation Centres

Laboratories and simulation centres contain specialised equipment and materials that require strict adherence to safety protocols. Your safety and the safety of others depends on following these procedures precisely.

1 Follow Instructor Guidance

Strictly follow all instructions provided by your instructor or laboratory supervisor. Never deviate from approved procedures.

2 Supervised Work Only

Work only in the presence of a qualified teacher or laboratory assistant. Unauthorised access or unsupervised work is strictly prohibited.

3 Use Protective Equipment

Always wear appropriate protective equipment including lab coats, gloves, masks, and safety glasses as required for specific procedures.

4 Follow Safety Rules

Adhere to all biological and chemical safety rules. Understand proper handling, storage, and disposal procedures for all materials.

5 Handle Equipment Carefully

Treat mannequins, simulators, and medical equipment with care. Report any damage or malfunction immediately to staff.

Safety in Dormitories and on Campus

Access Control

Do not allow unauthorised individuals to enter dormitory buildings without explicit permission from administration. Always verify visitor identity.



Prohibited Items

Do not store flammable materials, prohibited electrical appliances, or dangerous substances in your accommodation.



Actions in Emergency Situations

Responding to Critical Incidents

Knowing how to respond correctly during emergencies such as earthquakes, fires, smoke, suspicious objects, or sudden illness can save lives. Preparation and calm action are essential.



Stay Calm

Remain calm and composed. Follow instructions from authorised personnel, security staff, or emergency responders.



Use Official Exits

Use only designated evacuation exits. Follow posted evacuation routes and do not attempt to use alternative paths.



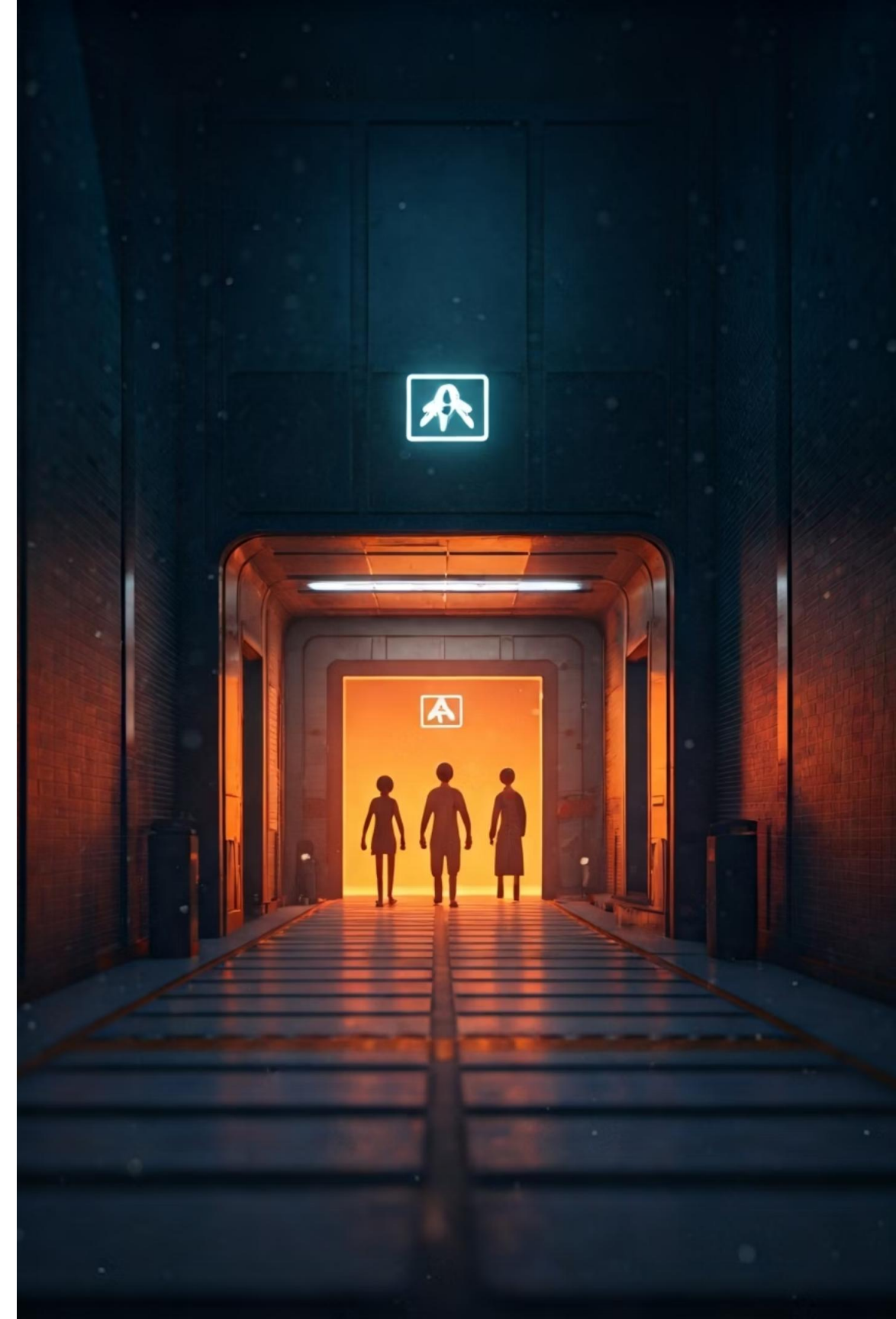
Avoid Elevators

Never use lifts or elevators during emergencies. Always use stairways for evacuation, even if it takes longer.



Maintain Safe Distance

Keep a safe distance from buildings, power lines, and glass structures. Move to designated assembly points.
